Frequently Asked Questions

How old do you have to be to participate in the Richmond Renaissance Cotillion?

Students must be enrolled in middle school (grades 6-8) and must be between 11 and 14 years old.

Do you have to be a member of Jack and Jill to participate in the Richmond Renaissance Cotillion?

No. The Richmond Renaissance Cotillion is open to all middle school students in Richmond and the surrounding regions.

How much does it cost to participate in the Richmond Renaissance Cotillion?

The participant fee is \$500 and is due by October 1, 2024:

*The leadership retreat and etiquette lunch is included. *The team-building activity is included.

- \$20 donation towards community service activity
- Long Gloves (Est \$9 \$12)
- Dress and Suit (Est \$100- \$120)

The Cotillion Committee has completed all the planning (vendor contracts and reservations) prior to the Informational Session based on the allotted participant slots; therefore, payments are non-refundable.

How many sessions is the Cotillion composed of?

There are seven (7) dance lessons, a full-day retreat, a team-building activity, a community service activity, and the Finale. The Finale is Sunday, February 23rd, 2025 3-6pm.

What is the dress code for the etiquette workshops and dance lessons? We request that boys dress in slacks and collared shirts with ties. Girls must wear dresses or skirts. No athletic or casual shoes. Dance lessons will require hard soled shoes.

Are parents allowed to observe the workshops or practices?

Space is limited in the dance hall but we will make an attempt to accommodate those parents who make a request. Generally, the sessions will be closed to parents.

What happens if a dance is canceled due to weather or other unforeseen circumstances?

If we need to cancel sessions, we will notify parents at least 4 hours prior to the scheduled session. We will follow up as soon as practical with any make-up sessions.

What is the dress lesson for the final event?

The Finale is a semi-formal event. We will provide specifics on the attire and required arrival times for the finale at the informational session and review again on a participant parent Zoom call to address any questions.
